THE FACULTY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Charge: The Faculty Development Committee shall receive from department chairpersons through the deans applications by faculty members for faculty development leaves. The Committee shall review these applications and make recommendations to the Executive Vice President and Provost, pursuant to published criteria for selection and announcement availability of such leaves. The Committee shall review criteria for selection and the extent of availability of leaves and make appropriate recommendations.

Membership: Fifteen members, divided between the Colleges, the Law School, and the administration, with at least one member representing each division.

Appointment: Members are elected for three-year terms. Faculty does not have to be tenured faculty.

THE INCENTIVE GRANT REVIEW PANEL

Charge: The Faculty Incentive Grant Review Panel is charged with the responsibility of reviewing and rating the Faculty Incentive Grant Proposals for the Teaching Learning, and Technology Center. Most of the work takes place early in the spring semester.

Membership: The panel shall be composed of elected faculty representatives. The distribution of representation shall be such that each degree-granting college shall have one representative, with the exception of Arts & Sciences, which shall have seven.

Appointment: The term of service is three years. Faculty does not have to be tenured faculty.

TENURE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
