CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Texas Tech University Graduate School is pleased to announce the second annual Arts and Humanities Graduate Research Conference. The conference, highlights graduate student scholarship in the arts and humanities.

The conference is an opportunity for graduate students to share their research with an educated, non-specialist audience making full use of available presentation technologies. The presentations will be reviewed by a panel of judges and scholarship awards will be given for the best presentations.

Students who present will also be invited to submit a 10-12 page scholarly paper based on the presentation (deadline November 9) that will be peer-reviewed for inclusion in a TTU Arts and Humanities Graduate Research Conference Proceedings. Scholarships for best scholarly proceedings papers will also be awarded.

Graduate Students doing scholarship in the Arts and Humanities are invited to submit 250-300 word abstracts for papers showcasing their current work. 36 papers will be chosen for presentation. Fields primarily defined as Arts and Humanities include (but are not limited to):


