Resolution on Presidential Searches, 11-14-12, #318

- 1. Whereas the President of the University governs the entire body of the University, and therefore she/he should be chosen with input from all major constituencies in the University.
- 2. Whereas the past two presidential search committees at Texas Tech University were constituted on an ad hoc basis and modified as the searches began.
- 3. Whereas peer institutions have written regulations stipulating substantial faculty representation on presidential search committees (see appendix, attached).

Be it resolved:

- 1. That the Regents and governing board shall draft a Regents' OP formally specifying the components of presidential search committees.
- 2. That this OP shall stipulate that faculty members nominated by the Faculty Senate shall constitute no less than one quarter of the Presidential Search Committee.
- 3. That if this OP also includes provisions for a Presidential Search Advisory Council, it shall stipulate that faculty members nominated by the Faculty Senate shall constitute no less than one quarter of the Presidential Search Advisory Council.
