### **Stipend**

As part of the Service Learning Scholars (SLS) program, faculty members will receive a \$1000 stipend. The stipend can be rewarded as discretionary funds or transferred to an account for travel funding, project materials/expense or to provide limited support for a student assistant. The length of the fellowship is 9 months.

### **Eligibility**

This program requires active participation. Participants must have participated in the Service Learning Faculty Fellows (SLFF) program before applying to participate in the SLS program. There is no specific limit to the number of times a faculty member can participate; however, preference will be given to first-time applicants
