Senate Resolution 41.16

(Stating the sentiments of the Student Senate concerning changes to the Rules of the Senate involving Standing Committees.)

WHEREAS, The Texas Tech University campus is rapidly growing, and evolving, and

WHEREAS, Many issues discussed in Student Senate include Improvements to the campus infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, There is currently no committee to address these areas, and

WHEREAS, The Duties of the Historical Committee such as campus traditions could be addressed by the University Life Committee.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Student Senate dissolves the Historical Standing Committee, and adds the Campus Infrastructure Advisory Committee and the Rules of the Senate be changed to read:

**“Rule IX**  
**STANDING COMMITTEES**

...**Section 9.** CAMPUS INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY COMMITTEE. All remaining Senators plus the Journal Clerk. This committee would be responsible for all legislation regarding improvements, or changes to the campus of Texas Tech University. This includes parking, grounds maintenance, facility improvements and construction, bike lanes, and road construction, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, This committee shall be charged with coordinating with the Facilities, Planning, and Construction Committee, and the Transportation Committee of the Student Government Association, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be spread upon the journal and that copies be sent to Dr. Michael Shonrock, Vice President for Student Affairs; Joey Kirk, Editor *The Daily Toreador*; and to the students of Texas Tech University.
