(Stating the sentiments of the Student Senate concerning the implementation of inactivity time limits on all public campus computers.)

WHEREAS, it is not uncommon for students to leave their accounts unattended, and

WHEREAS, personal information can be accessed by third parties on actively logged-in accounts, and

WHEREAS, pay-to-print fees are tracked through eRaider accounts, and

WHEREAS, the automated log-off technology currently exists in limited capacity on campus.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Student Senate requests that all public access computers on campus be equipped with inactivity log-off timers, and
