Shipping and installation charges should be included in the estimated cost.</p> <p>Any equipment less than \$5,000 (including computers) should be called "uncapitalized equipment."</p> <p>Permanent equipment is excluded from F&A costs.</p> <p>Uncapitalized equipment is subject to F&A costs.</p>
