"Public Property" includes thoroughfares, streets, sidewalks, and parking facilities that are within the campus or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus. Although crime statistics for property meeting this definition are included in this report, the Texas Tech System has no authority or responsibility for security policies, procedures, or safety at these locations.
