Requirements:

To be considered for a professional development scholarship, you must:

- be fourteen (14) years of age or older at the time of enrollment;
- be a United States citizen or authorized to work in the United States; and
- comply with the United States Selective Service System registration requirements, if the individual is male.

A copy of the valid documents must be submitted with the scholarship application form.

Valid Documentation includes:

- U.S. Citizen or permission to work in the U.S (and date of birth)
 - o Provide copies of one of the following
 - § Birth Certificate or U.S. Passport
 - § Noncitizen Authorization to Work Form or I9
- Copy of Social Security Card
- Copy of Driver's License (if applicable)

Scholarship recipients must complete the online professional development course within 60 days of registration. If not completed in the allotted time frame, you will be billed for the cost of the course. Upon completion of the course, the recipients will complete an evaluation survey and send it to Kelly.Sinclair@ttu.edu
