CHEMICAL WASTE

Container Re-Use

- Container must be compatible with the contents.
- Triple rinse and collect the rinsate before repurposing as a waste container.
- Cover the original container label.
- Have an EHS Waste label affixed.
- Use vented caps for wastes with the potential to produce gas or build pressure. (vent caps are FREE)

Do Not

- Do not mix incompatible wastes.
- Do not mix organic and inorganic wastes.
- Do not mix acid and base wastes.
- Do not mix halogenated and non-halogenated wastes.
- Do not use metal cans to collect corrosive waste.

Vented caps are FREE from EHS

Use vented caps for wastes with the potential to produce gas or build pressure.

- Write in the emailed transaction number
- Test pH
- Check the hazard box(es)
- Clean drips and spills from the container
