V. New Business

Dr. Sheridan introduced Dr. Claudia Cogliser (Associate Dean of the Graduate School) and Dr. Darryl James (Associate Vice Provost for Graduate Affairs) as the two new members to the Graduate School staff.

Dr. Sheridan stated that he has sent out a nine point update to all Graduate Deans and will be visiting all department chairs in the Colleges.

Dr. Sheridan stated that the Graduate School is the official admitting point in the process and the departments make the recommendations for admittance.

Dr. Darryl James has been working on the guidelines for the 150 hour program or combined baccalaureate master's program.

All Graduate Council members signed up to serve on a subcommittee, whether it be Graduate Faculty Committee, Academic Program committee, Student Affairs committee.

Enrollment is up by 10% this fall compared to last fall numbers. Will have the final count soon.

Dr. Cogliser gave the August 2014 graduation numbers: 122 Doctoral, 318 Masters, and 39 certificates.
