

I-20 Extension Instructions

Overview

U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) requires that you finish your program of study by the completion date on your I-20. The end date on the I-20 is established by the admissions office to reflect the average length of time it should take a student to complete the degree requirements. If, during the course of your studies it becomes necessary to extend your I-20, our office can provide I-20 extensions to those who are eligible and apply in a timely fashion.

Eligibility


In order to obtain a program extension, you must show that you have continually maintained status and that the extension is needed for compelling academic or medical reasons, such as a change of major or research topic, unexpected research problems, or a documented illness. An I-20 which has already passed the program end date cannot be extended.

If your program end date has expired or you do not meet the eligibility requirements to apply for a program extension, it will be necessary to file for reinstatement to F-1 status with USCIS, for which you will have to pay a substantial fee.

Required Documentaton

The following documents must be completed and submitted to the ISSS office:

- Academic Advisor's Recommendation for Extension form (page 2)
- Graduate School Extension Recommendation form (page 3, graduate students only)
