- Contest materials are TMSCA, A+ Computer Science, HEXCO, and Maverick Productions.
- Math, Number Sense, Calculator, and Science events will be divided into grade levels by divisions.
- Please ensure your student's name, school, and event are on each page in Journalism and Ready Writing
- Send only scores back to the UIL Officials, not the tests.
- The UIL Official will email your school copies of the tests and answers on Thurs. Dec. 4th.
- All Journalism and Ready Writing should be emailed or faxed. Regional judges will grade each one.
- Current Events, Social Studies, and Literary Criticism essays should also be emailed with the student's name, school, and event on each page. Regional judges will grade each one.
- Only Journalism, Ready Writing, and essays from Current Events, Social Studies, and Literary Criticism will be sent to our office. Do not send the C.E., S.S., or Lit.Crit. tests; only essays. Send scores of all tests on result forms.
- Once results have been received and graded, the UIL official will post results in Google Sheets (accessible via QR code on this page). They will also mail all material and awards as soon as possible and announce the scholarship winners.
- Your school and coaches will administer the tests at your convenience. All results should be received no later than noon, Dec. 12 2025 to jack.barton@ttu.edu.

AWARDS

- Math, Number Sense, Calculator, Science: 1st 3rd medals, 4th 6th ribbons per grade/per contest/per division
- Non-Math/Science events: 1st 3rd medals, 4th 6th ribbons per event/division
- 1st and 2nd team awards: per event/division; 1st and 2nd Sweepstakes award: per division

SCHOLARSHIPS

- The College of Engineering is offering a \$2,000 scholarship to the top senior score in calculator in each division and \$500 in Computer Science in each division.
- The Math Department is offering a \$500 scholarship to the top senior score in both the Number Sense and Math contest.
- The College of Media & Communication will award a \$300 scholarship to the top combined Journalism scores in each division.
- The History Department will award \$500 to overall winner of Current Events and Social Studies.
- The Rawls College of Business will award \$1000 to overall winner of Accounting.
- The Chemistry Department will award \$500 to the top overall score in chemistry.
- The English Department will award \$300 to the top overall score in Literary Criticism.

*Scholarships will only be applied if students enroll in Texas Tech University.
