AWARDS

- Math, Number Sense, Calculator, Science: 1st 3rd medals, 4th 6th ribbons: per grade/per contest/ per division
- Non-Math/Science events: 1st 3rd medals, 4th 6th ribbons: per event / per division
- 1st and 2nd team awards: per event / per division; 1st and 2nd Sweepstakes award: per division
- Coaches may pick up materials as soon as results are recorded. We will use a QR code for seeing
 results as they come in and will post results in the hall. A \$5.00 postage fee for schools desiring their
 packet to be mailed. Trophies will not be mailed.

- Number Sense: The top senior score in all three divisions: \$500
- Calculator: The top senior score in all three divisions: \$2,000
- Math: The top senior score in all three divisions: \$500
- Chemistry: The top score overall: \$500
- Accounting: The top score overall: \$1000
- Social Studies: The top score overall: \$500
- Current Events: The top score overall: \$500
- Computer Science: The top score in all three divisions: \$500
- Journalism: The top student in each division: \$300
- Literary Criticism: The top score overall: \$300
