Performance placement is determined alphabetically by the Area's play title. Performance times may be altered for reasons deemed necessary by the Contest Manager.

Each school shall pay a \$850 one-act play fee (fee is not covered in Spring Meet fee)

This fee must be presented at the time of rehearsal or earlier.

No fee for individual participants is required.

Schools should make checks payable to: Texas Tech UIL.

An awards ceremony will be held in the theatre following critiques.

The critic judges will provide critiques 30 minutes after the last show.

The UIL approved "unit set" is available for all entrants' utilization. Except for French doors, no door units or windows are available. Please bring your own. They do not have to be placed in your square.
