AWARDS

- Math, Number Sense, Calculator, Science: 1st – 3rd medals, 4th – 6th ribbons: per grade/per contest/per division
- Non-Math/Science events: 1st – 3rd medals, 4th – 6th ribbons: per event / per division
- 1st and 2nd team awards: per event / per division; 1st and 2nd Sweepstakes award: per division
- Chess Puzzles not scored for sweepstakes
- Coaches may pick up materials as soon as results are recorded. We will use a QR code for seeing results as they come in and will post results in the hall. A \$5.00 postage fee for schools desiring their packet to be mailed. Trophies will not be mailed.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Number Sense:** The top senior score in all three divisions: \$500
- **Calculator:** The top senior score in all three divisions: \$2,000
- **Math:** The top senior score in all three divisions: \$500
- **Chemistry:** The top score overall: \$1000
- **Accounting:** The top score overall: \$500
- **Social Studies:** The top score overall: \$500
- **Current Events:** The top score overall: \$500
- **Computer Science:** The top score in all three divisions: \$500
- **Journalism:** The top student in each division: \$300
- **Literary Criticism:** The top score overall: \$300

Scholarships will only be applied if students enroll in Texas Tech University. Scholarships are not transferrable.
