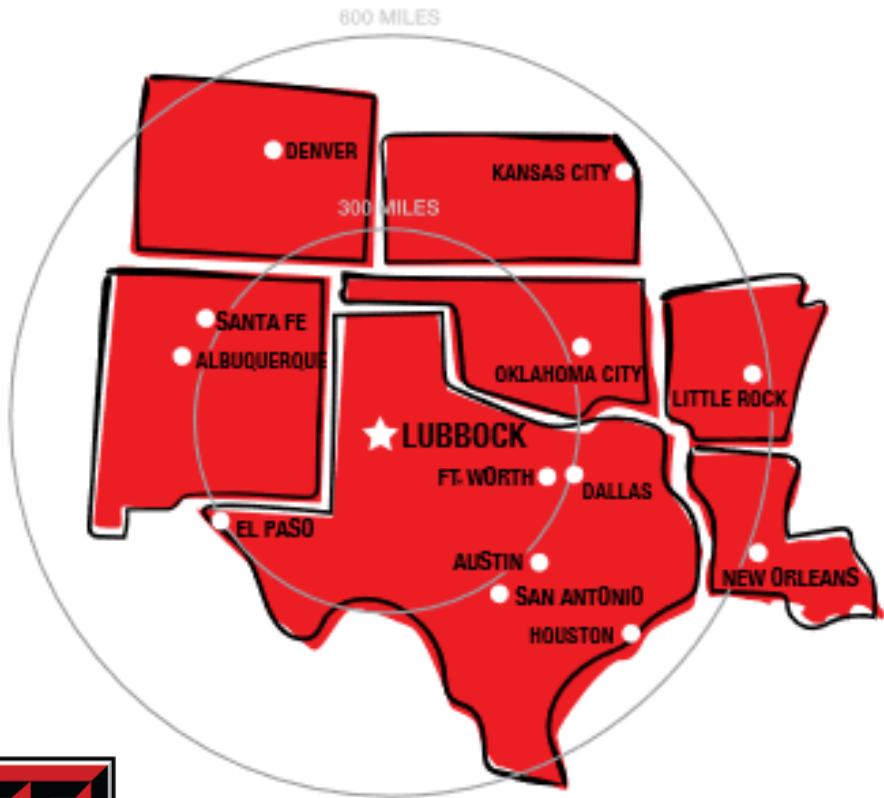

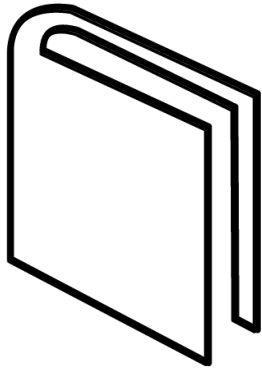

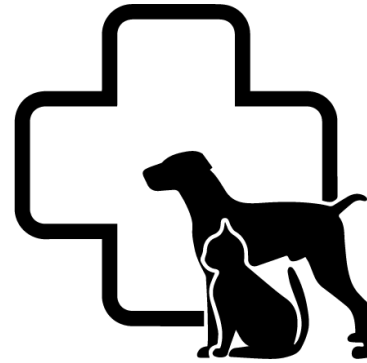

- Application – Common App or Apply Texas
- \$75 Application Fee or Fee Waiver
- Create a RaiderConnect Account
- High School Transcript
 - Submit official college transcript with any dual credit taken
- Official SAT and/or ACT Scores (Optional)

Notification of Decision in 2-4 Weeks



ADMISSIONS

FEE WAIVERS

Demonstrated financial hardship:

Option 1: Submit FAFSA

- SAI of \$0
- Family's income meets the Income Eligibility Guidelines for National School Lunch Program (traditional freshmen only)

Option 2: Provide an Accepted Fee Waiver

- For Spring & Fall 2025 Applicants, TTU will accept official fee waivers from NACAC, SAT & ACT

Option 3: Submit TTU Fee Waiver Request Form

- 2023 Income Tax Form – Page 1
- [or] Documentation of subsidized housing, foster home, homelessness, public assistance, ward of the state or orphan

Eligibility:

U.S. Citizens

[or] Permanent Resident

[or] SB 1528 Texas Resident

ADMISSIONS

TEST OPTIONAL POLICY

- Test optional for admission and scholarships through Fall 2025
- Holistic application review process
- Score will be hidden if already on file
- Can be re-evaluated for admission if a test score is submitted
- Must still meet TSI requirements prior to enrollment
- Restricted academic majors will evaluate holistically



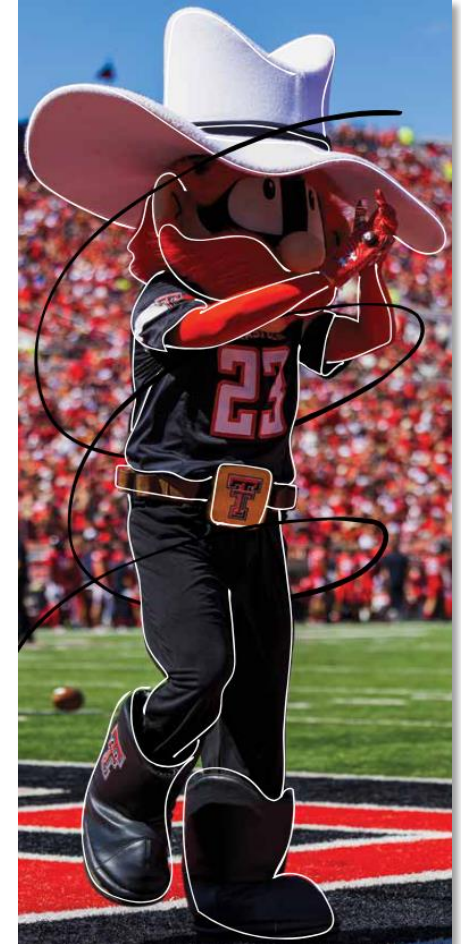

ADMISSIONS

APPLICATION REVIEW PROCESS

Students who do not submit ACT and/or SAT scores on their application or do not meet assured admission will be evaluated holistically.

- Academic course selection (Honors, AP, Pre-AP, Dual Credit, IB)
- Essays & Letters of Recommendation
- Extracurricular activities
- Leadership experiences
- Civic or other service activities
- Socioeconomic background
- Family educational background
- Special talents or awards
- Diversity of experience and background

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS - FRESHMEN

Arts & Sciences - Biology, Cell & Molecular Biology, Microbiology & Physics

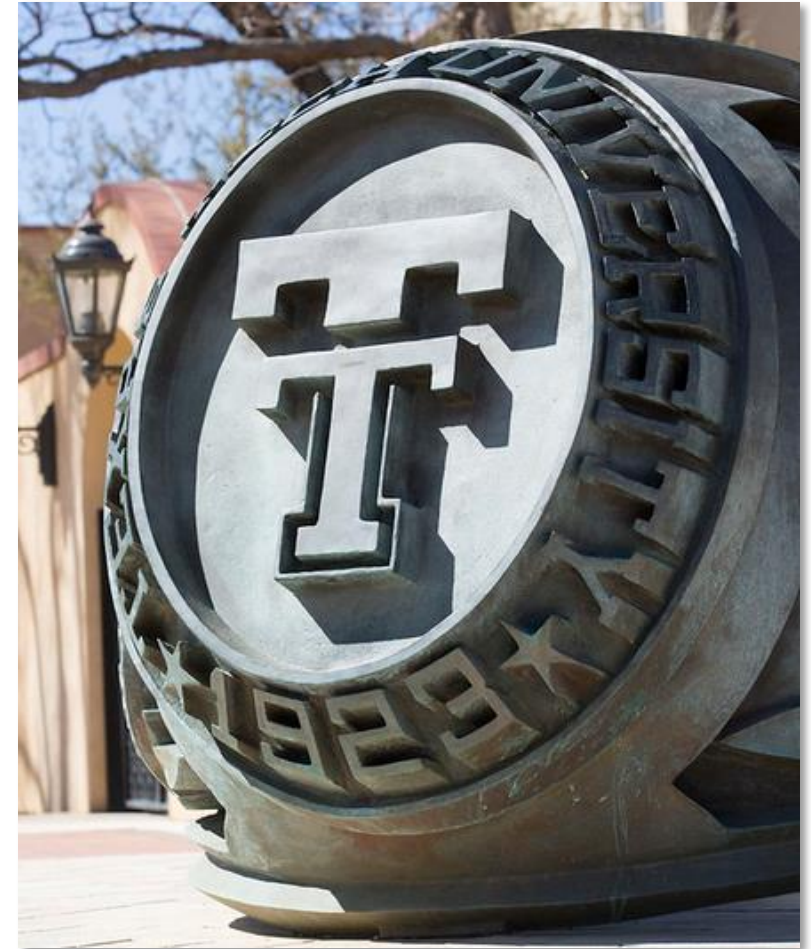

 - Must submit official high school transcript if fewer than 12 transferrable hours.

ACT composite score; SAT reflects evidence-based reading and writing, and math; the highest section scores from multiple tests on the ACT and SAT will be used to maximize score. These awards are for the 2025-2026 academic year and are subject to change without notice. No additional application is required. Students must enroll in a minimum of 12 hours for fall & spring terms.

RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

Awards of \$7,000-\$9,000 3.5 GPA & 30 TTU hours

Awards of \$3,000-\$6,500 3.25 GPA & 30 TTU hours

Awards of \$1,000-\$2,500 3.0 GPA & 30 TTU hours

Awards are renewable for up to 4 consecutive years (eight total terms).

Transfer Merit Scholarships are guaranteed for students who have transcripts and other required documents submitted by July 31 for Fall entry or January 15 for Spring entry. Scholarships are renewable for up to three consecutive years (six total terms). Students must enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours; 9 must be TTU hours. Scholarships are awarded after June 1 based on availability of funds (fall entry). Students with approved consortium agreements must take a minimum of 9 TTU hours. Transferable hours exclude credit hours from AP, CLEP, or military credits. Students must meet all criteria to qualify.



FINANCIAL AID

RED RAIDER GUARANTEE

Red Raider Guarantee ensures tuition and mandatory fees up to 30 credit hours per year, will be paid by a combination of federal, state, and institutional funds.

Qualifications:

- Entering New First-Time student
[or] Transfer student who has earned an associate's degree
- Eligible to complete the FAFSA or TASFA
- Texas Resident
- Family AGI of \$65,000 or less
- Must have demonstrated financial need
- Full-time enrollment (at least 12 hours) each Fall/Spring semester

Deadline – February 15, 2025

- Must be admitted and have a complete financial aid file by deadline
