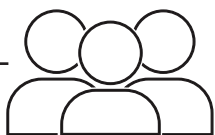

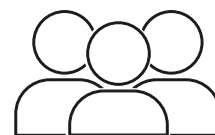

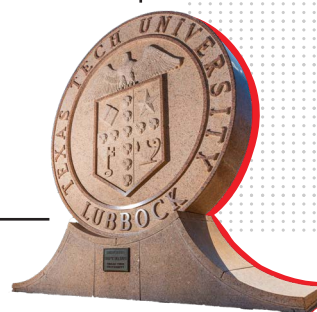

NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

You could qualify for Texas resident tuition and fees when awarded at least \$1,000 in competitive scholarships from Texas Tech per academic year.

STUDENT SUPPORT

Texas Tech provides support to international students as they earn their degrees through academic and faculty advising, tutoring services, on-campus housing and International Student Services such as:

International Student Orientation

Features multiple workshops to help you adapt to life at Texas Tech. Here you will meet other international students and your immigration advisor.

International Student & Scholar Services (ISSS)

ISSS staff assist with students' immigration processes, institutional compliance and reporting requirements, financial concerns, cross-cultural issues, campus and community integration.

Working On Campus

Texas Tech offers opportunities for students to earn money by working on campus for the university. International students with an F-1 visa are allowed to work on campus. Reach out to your ISSS advisor to learn more.

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

Take part in Optional Practical Training to gain work experience in your field. OPT allows international students with an F-1 visa to stay in the U.S. and do paid work related to their degree after graduation. You can work for up to 1 year or extend up to 3 years if your degree is in a science, technology, engineering or mathematics (STEM) field. To find Texas Tech's STEM-eligible programs contact your ISSS advisor.
