

The TTU Pre-Law Ambassadors is a department-led organization that provides information and outreach to current and prospective Pre-Law students. This group of students will be responsible for supporting the continued growth of the TTU Pre-Law Program through their participation in and outreach for Pre-Law workshops and seminars, community service events, and mentorship. A typical Ambassador commits 10-12 hours per month to the program during the Fall and Spring semesters. **Ambassador applicants will begin their duties in the Spring 2026 semester.**

Students must meet the following requirements to be considered for an ambassador position:

- Must be enrolled in at least 12 hours (full time) at Texas Tech University and have completed 15 college hours.
- Must be here for at least two semesters. (Ex: If applying for Spring 2026, you cannot graduate in May 2026)
- Exhibit strong interpersonal communication skills.
- Be a positive and productive team member.
- Possess enthusiasm and eagerness to promote the TTU Pre-Law Program and represent Pre-Law professionally students to parents, prospective students, current students, and TTU executive administration.
- Attend 2 of the 3 monthly meetings (meetings are held on the first Wednesday of every month at 5:30 pm).
- Serve as mentee/mentor to other pre-law students through our mentorship program.

<u>Candidates selected for interviews will be notified by email on Monday November 10th, and interviews will be</u> held November 17th-20th.

Applications are due by 12:00 pm on Friday November 7th.
