Lt Col Daniel R. Hall is the Commander of the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 820 at Texas Tech University. He leads, develops and mentors approximately 140 cadets and active duty members. Additionally, he serves as the Texas Tech University Professor of Aerospace Studies and the Aerospace Studies Department Chair.

Lt Col Hall earned his commission through AFROTC at Texas Tech University in 2004 and has served more than 20 years on Active Duty in the Air Force. He has served as an airfield operations officer and combat airspace manager at the squadron, wing, numbered Air Force, HAF and Joint levels. Prior to his current position, Lt Col Hall was the Commander, 88th Operations Support Squadron, 88th Air Base Wing, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base (AFB), Ohio where he led more than 90 personnel from 11 diverse career fields. He was responsible for the overall administration of the squadron and day-to-day operations of base weather, flight records, munitions, airfield operations, Radar, Airfield and Weather Systems, and special aviation operations. He also oversaw 1 of 5 locations Air Force-wide selected for 13M Follow-on Skills Training, ensuring the next generation of Airfield Operations Officers were properly trained for operational assignments and prepared to meet future challenges of the career field.
