## **AECGO Qualification & Requirements for Travel Funding**

- 1. Active dues-paying members can apply for funding through AECGO (Active means you must attend 75% of official meetings and events held throughout the academic year).
- 2. AECGO members must be actively participating in kitchen clean-up shifts each semester to be eligible for funding.
  - a. This only applies to any member whose office is located in or actively uses the fridge or microwaves located in the Agricultural Education and Communication Building.
- 3. The member requesting the funding must be the first or second author or actively presenting research papers, posters, educational sessions, or professional development sessions to qualify for AECGO funding.
- 4. AECGO will not financially support members attending without presenting in some capacity, as explained above.
- 5. AECGO will only cover the costs of transportation, accommodations, and food. AECGO does not cover registration fees and alcohol.
- 6. AECGO will not support any member's funding requests that are in violation of anything within the Student Code of Conduct set by Texas Tech University.
- 7. AECGO will not support any member's funding requests that are in violation of the standing rules or constitution of AECGO.

Note: AECGO Officers will review all funding applications to ensure all members seeking travel support meet all requirements and qualifications as stated in the AECGO Constitution.
