It would have been appreciated to understand why an answer could not be achieved even when a question was tried multiple times.
(Jhones Sarturi) Dr. Sarturi was effective in teaching material but came off to have an attitude sometimes when asking for assistance. I understand the stress of the job and the changes that have been made, but even in person or in class he does not seem to be very approachable. You are not able to pop in his office at any time which is another disadvantage. I understand making an appointment for the organization, but even when making an appointment he ignored the fact that he had somebody to meet. Overall, he is very passionate about his job and the material he teaches, but could be more approachable in the process.
(Jhones Sarturi) Very important class for anybody who wants to go into the feed business!
(Jhones Sarturi) I wish more info would have been disclosed about the service-learning project and what we actually had to do rather than just leaving us guessing a bit, but overall really fun class and wonderful professor

An example problem of each could be taught to us, then we could be given work and do it ourselves. It is extremely frustrating, especially to those who are unfamiliar with this field.

(Jhones Sarturi) Dr. Sarturi is a very good passionate teacher
(Jhones Sarturi) He's very passionate about what he does and it shows in the course.
(Jhones Sarturi) attendance could have been better taken or not on top hat throughout the semester.
(Jhones Sarturi) Understanding and engaging professor that would get the job done from the beginning.
(Jhones Sarturi) The instructor used course fees paid by the graduate student to conduct a research experiment using graduate students as his source of labor. Class and in lab material was good. Research trial was a preliminary trial for him and extorted the student to do the work and analysis. The actual experiment did not aid in learning objectives. Professor expected way to much time, approximately 85 hours over expected classroom and lab work. No regards for personal time. Analysis and data collections times were sometimes until 1 am in the morning including weekends. Blatant disregard for current research students were doing, other classes or personal time.

(Jhones Sarturi) Throughout this course, I felt very belittle. I'm a graduating senior and never had a professor make me feel bad about myself. I would ask a question about the class but instead of answering he would ask the class instead. Sometime I just ask a question to make sure I know the information. This happen several time to me this semester. Overall, it make me really embarrassed in class which could be handle in differently.

(Jhones Sarturi) Dr. Sarturi is a very knowledgeable professor and brings an energy to the classroom that is rarely seen at the university level. His exams are challenging but easy enough to do well on with the right commitment and studying habits. The only suggestion I would make would be to re-evaluate the group project. It is a good idea in theory but perhaps should be changed to a individual project that does not rely so heavily on the participation of other students. I understand that group work can be an important lesson to work through but if it is to remain as a group project perhaps lower the percentage of the overall grade it is worth. I do see the merit in the project and therefore do not think it should be eliminated.

(Jhones Sarturi) Dr. Sarturi truly cares about each of his students and wants to see them succeed! With Covid and other extracurricular activities on campus that would result in absences, I appreciated his open door policy that allowed students to visit with him to go over material we may have missed.

(Jhones Sarturi) I think the online tophat platform could be used to teach this entire class instead of having any in person classes. however, i think the math for this class needs to be more clear with definite equations for variables that dont change every problem to problem. the math is extremely confusing and unclear when it is taught. then the exam math is not the same or makes sense cause its just slightly different than it is in class. the project is extremely hard to understand and successful perform. there needs to be more guidance and i think the due dates should be earlier in the semester so that the group can fully understand the project before they present and just wing it.

(Jhones Sarturi) I learned so much from his class, he is a GREAT professor who is passionate about teaching. I appreciate how much I have learned from him.

(Jhones Sarturi) Dr.Sarturi has always been one of my most helpful and understanding teachers he really goes the extra mile for those that struggle in his class and keeps it engaging

(Jhones Sarturi) Dr. Sarturi is a good guy but I do not agree with his teaching style. His lectures this semester were hard to follow and the little time he did have in class with us was practically pointless. In most classes, the professor teaches during the in person class time and supplements lecture material online or through blackboard. Dr. Sarturi supplemented his class during the face to face time he had and left his hard to follow lecture material on Top Hat. This class was painful.

(Jhones Sarturi) May just be me, but his teaching style was awful, this class was a pain in person and I dreaded going to it ever day. Every student that I had spoken to in this class struggled and Dr. Sarturi was no help. His teaching style was very frustrating and confusing.

When I asked him for any tips to do well on the poster group project for this class, he immediately shut down the fact that multiple previous students had said that this was not a fairly graded assignment and became defensive towards students just asking for genuine help.

(Jhones Sarturi) Thank you!

(Jhones Sarturi) Loved this class just wish we could have continued in class!

(Jhones Sarturi) Really enjoyed this class!

(Jhones Sarturi) I'm gonna be honest this was the hardest class I've ever taken . I'm not good at math I just dont understand it no matter how many times I do it ! This course had 95% math of the time and I didn't get it ! I'm very fortunate with the grade I got I'm super blessed I have the grade that I have ! I just hope I can get those extra 7 points to pass . This course is not the best class for a person that sucks at math

(Jhones Sarturi) He is an amazing professor, he is very dedicated and understanding to the students and issues going on. Additionally, he takes time to sit down and actually work with you and problems. He maneuvers around any issue or absences that students have. The class itself is pretty hard because it is a senior level course but if students were giving actual study guides, I feel it would be a whole better.

(Jhones Sarturi) I understand the course is a senior level course but when covering the material for the exams isn't clear all the time which makes it harder to study for but we were given reviews which did help. Additionally, I always left labs confused because I was never sure what the homework was asking for.
(Jhones Sarturi) Dr. Sarturi is an excellent teacher and truly passionate about his work which resulted in this class being one of my favorites that I have taken.
(Jhones Sarturi) Loved this class so much! Thank you for your time and effort in this class!
(Jhones Sarturi) Group projects are not fun and extremely hard on the few people who do the work. The test were the right amount of difficulty.
(Jhones Sarturi) Lots of little busy work, had to stay on top of work and really understand content for the tests.
(Jhones Sarturi) Several of the aspects of the class are not accurately presented for use in real-world scenarios as he describe they are. Dr. Sarturi also believes that there is usually only one way to approach a scenario when in reality there are several ways to approach it and still come out with the correct answer. His exams on the other hand, are based off of the lectures and study problems given throughout the course, but when discussing the case-studies as well as in lab discussions, there seems to be a large amount of students that seem to be confused due to the fact that each mind thinks differently and each person has their own way of thinking and understanding the question at hand.
(Jhones Sarturi) Overall, this class for the first few weeks was a valuable learning experience when we were in the classroom lecturing. When we got to the last few weeks of the class after our project, we spent approximately 1 week on guest lecturers when I feel like that week could have been better utilized learning more about how to analyze the data through SAS and have more time to figure out the best ways to illustrate the data we collected. I also feel like we should have spent more time going over the project itself before we began, so that people that did not already know about the project in full. It seemed like the individuals that were not already involved on the project were left to figure out parts of this project on their own when it came to the final report. There was also a bit of bias in the class towards the graduate students that already knew about this project and had resources to better help them understand the project, as well as formatting their final project report. Overall, I think more time needs to be spend preparing for the final report rather than worrying about guest speakers that aren't going to be utilized for things pertaining to the class. I also feel as though more communication would be beneficial for students that are involved in other activities such as jobs, etc.
(Jhones Sarturi) Dr. Sarturi was a very compassionate and understanding professor that was willing to work with students when conflicts arose or they were struggling in a concept that was being covered in class. Dr. Sarturi was always willing to meet with us to go over our homework assignments or just get extra practice where we felt we were struggling. I really enjoyed Dr. Sarturi and his ANSC 3307 course.
(Jhones Sarturi) Very hands on with his students and try's his hardest to help students learn
(Jhones Sarturi) There's so much to say. Firstly, I think this professor is still struggling to overcome the English-language barrier. I found it hard to ask him questions because he would answer a 'question' that I was not asking him, and would leave my actual question unanswered (very frustrating). Additionally, there were times on exams where sentence structure was bad enough that interpreting the questions was more challenging than the question itself. I also think his math his math skills are questionable at times. Mostly though, I found him very condescending which made me lose interest in the class very quickly. The information taught was alright, but overall it was a fair enough miserable experience. (I should make an A so this is also not just me being bitter.)

(Jhones Sarturi) It's obvious that Dr. Sarturi really loves teaching this class & his enthusiasm helps to make it enjoyable for everyone.
(Jhones Sarturi) Great beneficial and fun class.
(Jhones Sarturi) The modality of this class was not beneficial. The lecture times were not beneficial. The material we went over in the lecture had a low level of supplementing the class. The lab portion was beneficial. The lecture material presented online via top hat was beneficial.
(Jhones Sarturi) Sarturi is a wonderful professor; He knows the names of everyone in a 65+ person class. He knows his material well and is always available to help a student if needed. I would recommend him to any and every student.
(Jhones Sarturi) Wonderful instructor, I really enjoyed him. Will look forward to taking him again.
(Jhones Sarturi) Great professor, fun and practical class.
(Jhones Sarturi) I like this class and found the information interesting and practical. Getting knowledge of use and access to the Beef Nutrient Requirement Model was amazing! I will say that Dr. Sarturi's tests did feel needlessly difficult at times. Also slightly confusing, mostly wording on questions that I personally struggled with.
(Jhones Sarturi) I love Sarturi's passion for the beef industry and the way he teaches this course. This is the most practical and applicable class I have had at this University!

(Jhones Sarturi) I spent the majority of the year crying over this specific class. I hated the way the math portions were presented specifically not having a clear cut way of doing them from the start and just random groups throwing numbers on the board then having to decipher what was wrong while still trying to learn. The group project is so intense and especially when it is likely two group members are going to bear the majority of the project. There is a difference in having leaders on a team and having a few good, hard working students who instead of battling their peers and having to repeatedly ask them to do things or holding their hand to get something done would rather do it themselves then have it done the wrong way. I think the flipped classroom is detrimental to the entire learning process. Instead of learning it became a race to consume mass amounts of information and then instead of learning what was already confusing in class, we had scenarios where if you didn't understand if felt very pressured and not geared towards learning but punishing. I had a big issue with a TA not reviewing the second exam. In a class like this it is vital to have a good review and especially for students who are doing their best and show up to class. It feels like the syllabus also was problematic, as a good student who always did my work and watched the videos school is difficult with a job and trying to balance everything. I think dropping a student based on attendance is a cruel policy if they can find a way to learn the information, afterall for some students we are PAYING to be here with a job that sometimes forces us to miss class. Overall the professor is a nice guy with solid intentions but I can't say I enjoyed the class. Truly I spent many nights up till 2 am trying to finish things and that's simply not a healthy way to have to go about school.

(Jhones Sarturi) I think this class was ok. The labs were very stressful as the math portions were poorly presented and generally confusing the homework also did not need to take hours to do.

(Jhones Sarturi) Overall, I enjoyed this course. However, the way that the first four homework/lab assignments were formatted resulted in me struggling with my grade. It would be more helpful if the students could either get the same questions for each attempt or, be able to see the right answers after the attempt is submitted to work the problems backward. I spent HOURS on homework assignments that I truly didn't have time for in the middle of my last semester.

Multiple times he told people that he was doing them a favor by letting them make up things that they missed due to excused absences, which is policy. This class could be a very informative class if the professor was not a jerk.

(Jhones Sarturi) I thought I signed up for a course about Lab Techniques. Little did I know, that I actually signed up to be someone else's grad student and free labor. The lab techniques aspect of this class is incredibly valuable and I have learned a lot. Unfortunately, the time commitment to the rest of the requirements completely negates any of the benefits of learning lab techniques. I have spent (as close as I can figure) approximately 85 hours outside of class doing this class's work, not including the number of times that class ran long and we all gave extra time in lab. That is 85 hours of time spent not doing work that my boss pays me to do, and instead providing free labor. For reference, the total amount of class hours is 72. So more than half again as much time spent outside of class hours. Not only is that not fair to the students that signed up for the class, that is not fair for the advisors, and professors who have other work and class for the students to do during that time. The complete lack of respect for students time was astounding, and made all the worse when we had to show up on the weekends and miss out on our own life plans for research that is not ours. I would never recommend this class to another student simply because of the labor involved, which is really a shame because the lab techniques part is very beneficial. If this class is ever taught again, the research project has to go. I did not learn anything, it did not benefit me, and I felt extremely disrespected and used due to the ridiculous time commitment required.

In my experience, every time I asked for help, the directions or the same explanation I did not understand was just repeated to me. This was not helpful as I clearly did not understand it the first time and that is why I was asking for extra help. I was made to feel less incompetent because I did not understand the terminology or type of explanations given. I also felt disrespected on multiple occasions by my instructor, even when it came to things out of my control. In my opinion, the grading rubric for this course is also not set up for the student's success. After having 2 classes with this grading rubric, I still end up less than a point away from an A with the only opportunity to acquire an A in the course is by making a 100 on the final. This does not seem practical and does not seem like a correct representation of the work I put into the course and becomes very frustrating as a dedicated student. This course should be a great opportunity for students to learn more about feeding animals in a way that applies to the industry. However, I was highly disappointed in my lack of a practical learning experience in this class.
