Kayla Wallace was an awesome TA who kept everything organized and running smoothly! I cannot sing high enough praises. The only recommendation I would have is to have a midterm in addition to the final, similar to the anatomy class she previously taught, so we are not having to study material all the way from August/early September for an exam taking place in late November/early December. This would allow for more in depth questions and less range of material.

I learned more in this class than I ever could have imagined and it was because of all the hands-on work that we were able to do EVERY week. There are students in the class with little to none clinic experience, so I find that unfair to those students. There's also the thought that the technicians at one clinic have the same responsibilities as techs at another. Not all clinics treat their techs the same way. 3) I did like how she would push everyone to do at least one thing hands-on. 4) Would like to see more mask reinforcement during the labs. We were still in confined spaces.
(Jessica Thomas) This class was extremely well done. I felt like I learned a lot and Dr. Thomas was very helpful in answering any questions relating to the field even if they weren't directly about her class. The best course I have taken at Texas Tech.
(Jessica Thomas) I took this class looking for small animal clinic experience, and honestly I felt like there was only one day for this. I think that this class should do more small animal focus since every other production class at tech does only large animals forcing those who want a focus in small animal to be out of luck. I also think that transport needs to be provided since not everyone can carpool and not everyone has a car and it is unreasonable to make students spend tons of money on gas. if it can't be provided then this class should be listed as one that requires outside transport so registering students don't get in a bind. I also think that projects and the final need to be clearly explained from the beginning. There was so much unknown in this class that it was practically impossible to study since there was way too much to study and nothing was made clear before the final or how exactly it would even work. It also needs to stop relying completely on participation, because if a student doesn't attend a class and has a valid excuse they will still be screwed on the quiz cause it relies on the attendance of last week and can't be taught by other students who didn't quite get it either. I was really disappointed with this class, because if i had known it would have such a huge focus on livestock and large animal, I would not have taken the class. I also think students should be warned and aware of what they will be doing before the class so that they don't ruin clothing or are not prepare properly. for instance, I thought the pig farm was inhumane and that whole process was inappropriate to make students do when they may have never cut into anything especially something that screams and wiggles in pain. It was upsetting honestly and slightly traumatizing, for I had never intentionally put something in pain before and would not have done it if I understood how it was going to happen before. also the class grade break down was extremely confusing cause it started changing at the end and frankly that was unreasonable. i loved the interview process and the spay and neuter, but outside of the very little small animal opportunities in this class, I really did not care for it. I thought that there was no direction or instruction to even clearly follow and it relied on students having clinical experience when I took this class to get more small animal tech experience. I think if Dr. Thomas wants this class to be successful it needs to start with basics and not get ahead of people by being too advanced. sutures and surgery should have been first and if they were so important to basically be the final the way they were, then it should have been focused on and revisited multiple times, like the math also. I get that it was suppose to teach us how to be more like graduate students, but frankly it just set some of us up for failure due to the disorganization and lack of proper communication.

This was very uncomfortable for me personally. She would struggle to follow the curriculum if she wasn't reading from her notes. The content was often either remedial or equivalent to content in my senior level courses. The homework is vague as to length but to complete the required amount 14+ pages of content every few weeks wasn't uncommon and this was in conjunction with a new group member as well.

It's a production course, and it should be challenging, but it definitely set me up poorly the first few weeks. I would rather it be easier than what was said on the first day rather than harder.
