It has gotten to the point I go to the shelter just to play with dogs because I've learned how to train them so by now it is just an hour to train a dog everything I've learned in this semester and now I help the shelter out more and play with dogs just to get them out of the kennels since I cleared the objective. Maybe lab should be required so those hours can go to the 25 required for the semester.

The teaching demos at the end of the year was a great way to experience how it may be to lead a dog training/behavior class, and I found the practice extremely useful! I think the most difficult thing was completing service hours, especially when my partner was not the most punctual when responding to times that worked for them. It was also a little frustrating to be on time when my partner was typically 30-45 minutes late. I know for the training evals it is important for us both to be there, but I feel like we should be able to go alone if we want when no videos are needed. That way if there were any issues one person could complete their hours even if their partner did not.

(Anastasia Stellato) The only critique that I can think of is to try to make it so that she is not reading directly from the slides so much. Reading directly off the slide when going over case studies is just fine. This is more for when describing concepts. What I have always been taught when making slides is to not put too much on them and to use them as a way to guide/outline the discussion or lesson rather than a direct script. Perhaps have more discussions of real-life scenarios on Blackboard throughout the semester to help with understanding. I know that a couple of students felt like the material was good in theory but did not feel that it was completely realistic in a vet clinic or home. There could even be a discussion board where students can post training questions and other students could try to provide advice on the situation, with the instructor to guide the discussion and make sure that the advice being given is correct.
