(Ryan Rathmann) This course is very challenging and I felt that some of the materials on the exams were not thoroughly covered but overall a very great learning experience

(Ryan Rathmann) This was the most practical class I have taken. I learned a lot of hard skills that I could take straight to the workforce.

(Ryan Rathmann) Expectation versus reality is often extremely disappointing. It's no secret amongst students enrolled in an Animal Science degree plan at Texas Tech University that the semester they must take "ANSC 3402- Animal Breeding and Genetics" will be a challenging one; almost any student here will tell you that. ANSC 3402 has long been noted as one of the most challenging courses in Animal Science. After finishing the course for myself, I won't disagree with that sentiment; however, it is not the course material that makes this class challenging. This was the single most disorganized, outdated, and unthoughtful class I have taken to date at TTU. It was taught by a professor who shows so little care about course curriculum and student success that little updates to course assignments and materials have been made since a decade ago in 2013. Dr. Rathmann's blithe attitude towards class has an equal effect on student success. I have watched a significant decline in my peers and my own personal academic drive to care, just as equally as we have seen our instructor incompletely teach lecture content, consistently push assignment/exam dates forward, and have a blasé attitude towards turning in assignments. Why should students care about completing coursework accurately when the fate of this work is a student assistant plugging in 100s in the grade book as a mere participation grade? Despite the lack of seriousness and chaos of the course framework, it is perhaps the greatest irony that midterm exams show no mercy. These 100-question exams are rigorous and, as claimed by Dr. Rathmann's "exam philosophy", are supposed to challenge the student to "analytical think and apply concepts." I respect this, I have had many courses where simply memorizing course content was not enough to score well on an examination, vet where was this expectation asked of us students in class on a weekly basis? Surely, it wasn't students being able to copy the previous work of TTU Alumni dating back to 2014 and receiving 100s on course assignments. Surely, it wasn't working out a singular math problem on the board once a week in lab and expecting students to execute this again two months later on an exam. But perhaps what seems to be most telling is that a few days ago, we received the news that our final examination in ANSC 3402 will be a 50-question fill-in-the-blank vocabulary test. Ask yourself if that follows Dr. Rathmann's claimed philosophy on examinations. Students need consistency, expectations, and, at the very least, organization in the courses that they pay thousands of dollars to take. If applied analytically thinking about animal breeding and genetics is what this course intends to do, then someone needs to be held accountable for driving this objective because it is far from what is happening.
