I am pleased to nominate Dr. Catherine Simpson for the Davis College Teaching Award. Dr. Simpson has exemplified the values we strive for in our teaching and student success since she joined our department in September of 2019. She has shown remarkable dedication to her students and has carried a substantial teaching and graduate advising role in our department, ensuring that our students have an excellent experience here at Texas Tech University.

Dr. Simpson is a talented and ambitious teacher. Since 2020, she has taught 600 students at both the undergraduate and graduate levels, with several of her courses having an integral lab component. She is an innovator, involving her classes in the Innovation Hub competition and encouraging them to create marketable projects. She strives to teach through hands-on activities and consistently receives very strong evaluations (average for all questions over all years: 4.60).
