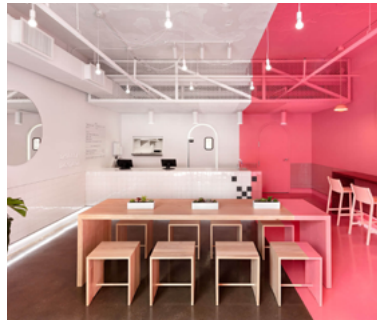

1. PROJECT DATA SHEET: Provide all relevant information about the project program, schedule, cost and square footage.
2. PROJECT NARRATIVE: Description of the design problem, the influencing factors on the design and a description of the design solution.
3. PROJECT GRAPHICS/PHOTOGRAPHY (12 SLIDES MAXIMUM): All information necessary, including photographs, to graphically illustrate the design concept/design solution. A graphic scale should be included on all applicable drawings.

IMPORTANT

1. Submissions by an entrant ("Entrant") must be received no later than July 11, 2025 (23:59 hours US Central Daylight Time) and must be submitted online via this link: surveymonkey.com/r/2TTPYQG.
2. A non-refundable payment of \$300 is required for each project submitted. Payments may be made at give.ttu.edu/dla. There is no limit to the number of projects that may be submitted for design award consideration. Any questions about payment should be sent to Yssis Hotchkins (yhotchki@ttu.edu).
3. The entrant MUST NOT self-identify (e.g. company or individual name, logo) on any of the submission PDFs.
4. By submitting an entry, the Entrant confirms that they have created all work submitted (the "Entry") or otherwise has the legal right to submit the Entry to this competition and that any required permissions or licenses associated with submission of the Entry has been obtained from the creator and/or owner (as applicable). Texas Tech University and the Texas Tech University Huckabee College of Architecture (together, "TTU") have no responsibility to verify ownership of the Entry and is not liable for any claims arising out of the use of the Entry. ENTRANT AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS TTU, INCLUDING THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AND AGENTS FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DAMAGES, LIABILITY, INCLUDING EXPENSES RELATED TO THE ENTRY.
