This award honors a graduate of the Texas Tech Huckabee College of Architecture whose career and professional life have brought distinction on the College and whose career as an architect is held in high esteem by peers and the general public. Individuals may be nominated under one of the Categories listed below.

CATEGORIES

DISTINGUISHED ARCHITECTURAL PRACTICE

- Exemplary achievement in design, evidenced by peer recognition in the form of national or regional awards, publications and other honors over a period of time
- Exemplary achievement in architectural practice management or technical expertise, with evidence of broad influence and sharing of knowledge
- Exemplary achievement and leadership in the AIA or related professional associations
- Unique, recognized and sustained achievement in other professional areas such as building codes, disaster recovery, sustainability, or historic preservation

COMMUNITY OR PUBLIC SERVICE

- Recognized public service in government, community development or elected office
- Distinguished military service, acts of exceptional heroism or philanthropy

DISTINGUISHED ACHIEVEMENT IN ARCHITECTURE EDUCATION OR PROFESSIONALLY RELATED FIELDS

- Distinguished achievement and leadership in architectural education, publication or research
- Distinguished achievement and leadership in a professionally related field, such as architectural illustration, photography or journalism

DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI SPIRIT

- Exemplary and outstanding service to and support of the Huckabee College of Architecture and/or Texas Tech University

NOMINATION SUBMISSION

The Nomination Submission shall consist of the following:

- Completed Nomination Form.
- Maximum one page letter of support from the Nominator, stipulating the Category under which the Nominee is submitted and setting forth the specific reasons for selection.
- Up to 10 additional pages (8.5" x 11") of supporting materials, specifically addressing the Nominee's qualifications and achievements in the category nominated.
