

## **General Information- Architecture Majors**

Majority of the architecture courses listed on your degree plan are offered in specific semester. Courses offered in the fall semester are designated fall only courses. While those offered in the spring semester are designated spring only courses. To stay on track for graduation, you need to register and successfully complete the courses in the semester offered. If you do not register or successfully pass a course, this will delay your intended graduation date.

- **All coursework listed on your architecture degree plan must be completed with a grade of “C or higher”. This includes all ARCH courses, core curriculum courses, and elective courses. Grades of “D” or “F” must be repeated.**
- **Undergraduate students must have a TTU GPA of 2.5 to graduate.**

### **Pre-Professional Program**

Competitive placement based on comprehensive review including student portfolio, GPA, statement of intent, and successful completion of all first-year architecture courses.

### **Course Enrollment**

It is recommended core course listed on your degree plan be taken prior to entering your 3<sup>rd</sup> year. If you choose not to take the number of hours specified for each semester of your program, you will need to complete those courses not taken during the long semesters in summer school sessions.

If you plan on taking your core courses at another institution and transfer them back to Texas Tech, please schedule an appointment with your academic advisor to verify the courses will apply to your degree.
