TTU School of Art Raider Create Camp Rules

1. The possession of the following items is not permitted: alcohol, tobacco, E-cigarettes, vape pens, illegal drugs or any other mood-altering substances, firearms, explosives, knives or weapons of any kind.
2. Campers will not venture onto any dormitory floor, other than your assigned floor; this includes dorm rooms and bathrooms. Non-camp guests are not allowed in the residence halls at any time.
3. Violence and physical altercations will not be tolerated.

The above rules are “zero tolerance” rules. Violation of any of these rules will result in immediate expulsion from camp and a call to parents for the camper to be picked-up. No refunds will be given.

1. No open flames are allowed at any time. This includes candles, incense, lighters, fireworks or any pyro-technical devices. These items will be removed from the camper and kept until the end of the camp session. All items will be returned to the parent when the camper is picked-up.
2. **Class etiquette:**
 - a. Attend all workshops daily. Campers are expected to budget their time wisely, including waking up on time, meals, etc.
 - b. Art is messy! Wear clothing that is appropriate for art class instruction. Swimsuits may only be worn to the afterhours pool night event.
 - c. No food or drinks are allowed in the studios and classrooms.
 - d. For safety, students will walk as a group to/from class. Students must be accompanied by a member of camp staff at all times.
 - e. Always be respectful of your instructors and classmates. In-person and online bullying will not be tolerated. Kindness is contagious!
3. **Residence Hall etiquette:**

- a. Room changes are only allowed through the residence hall main office. If you feel a room change is necessary, please contact camp staff.
- b. Keep your valuables safe! Make sure your dorm room door is locked anytime you are away. TTU and the School of Art are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- c. Do not tamper with air conditioning vents, smoke detectors, fire prevention sprinkler heads, or windows. Windows must always remain closed and free of signs and graffiti.
- d. Keep dorm rooms tidy and free of food and trash. Trash bins are located in the hallway of your dorm floor.
- e. Running in halls and over-crowding or playing in elevators is prohibited. Misuse of elevators may result in the university disabling them and campers will be required to use the stairs.
- f. Respect your roommate and other campers.
 - i. Practice good personal hygiene. Washers and dryers are located on your dorm floor and are free to use.
 - ii. Keep loud noise and cell phone usage to a minimum during sleep hours.
- g. Please be courteous to residence hall and dining hall staff. Summer camps are a big undertaking for our university staff and a kind word goes a long way. They are working hard to make your camp experience enjoyable.
- h. Clear your dining table of trays and trash at the end of your meals.
- i. Keep common areas clear of trash and clutter.
- j. Be aware of and read fire, severe weather and other emergency procedures for your residence hall.
