- Minimum hours requirements: 120 hours are required overall. 40 hours must be JR/SR level. 30 hours must be taken in residence.
- CLEP credit cannot be used to meet residency requirements.
- Refer to the minor requirements to determine appropriate courses for areas of study; consult with BGS advisor to confirm.
- Areas of concentration should not overlap in subject matter unless a course is specifically required for that area. Individual courses may not apply to more than one area.
- If all areas of study are A&S, up to 24 hours of coursework taken outside the college may apply; if one area is outside A&S, up to 30 hours of coursework outside the college may apply.
- No block credit may apply to major/minor/areas of study, core, university, or general education requirements.
