Minutes for Meeting of February 11, 2008**

A scheduled meeting of ASCAP was held on Monday, February 11 at 3:00 p.m. in Holden Hall 129. Committee members present were: Ken Baake, Jim Clopton, Greg Gellene, Ram Iyer, Anthony Qualin, Mark Stoll, and David Roach. Presenter was: David Lamp (Physics)

1. Committee voted to recommend to the next level of consideration the following proposals from the Department of Physics:
 - Change following courses from 4:3:2 format to 4:3:3 format--expand each lab meeting from 2 hours to 3 hours.
 - PHYS 1403 General Physics I
 - PHYS 1404 General Physics II
 - PHYS 1408 Principles of Physics I
 - PHYS 2401 Principles of Physics II

2. Committee discussed the following proposal from the Institute for Modern Conflict, Diplomacy and Reconciliation. The committee needs more information and will detail these needs to the proposers.
 - Add Graduate Certification Program in Strategic Studies

3. Committee voted affirmatively that "In principle, the College of Arts and Sciences could house a Doctor of Medical Physics Program." The committee felt that certain needs and issues would need to be successfully addressed for this program to be approved. The committee will detail these needs and issues to the proposers.
