 - Add PHYS 6309 Advanced Quantum Mechanics.
 - Add PHYS 6312 Quantum Field Theory.
 - Title change for PHYS 3304 from “Modern Physics Laboratory” to “Intermediate Physics Lab.”
 - Title change for PHYS 4307 from “Introduction to Quantum Mechanics” to “Quantum Mechanics – I.”

2. Pending minor revision, the committee voted to recommend to the next level of consideration the following course proposal from the Department of Department of Mathematics and Statistics:
 - Add MATH 3372 Math Modeling for Teachers.

3. The committee voted to recommend to the next level of consideration the following proposal from the Department of Health, Exercise, and Sport Sciences:
