VISIT OUR 5 PREPAREDNESS STATIONS

HOME SAFETY (BC & FMO): Learn simple ways to make your home safer and prepare for emergencies.

SHELTER PLANS (BC): Learn how to prepare for sheltering during severe weather and other emergencies.

IDENTIFICATION SYSTEMS (BC & LPD): Explore identification tools and strategies that can help keep individuals safe during an emergency.

WANDERING PREVENTION (BC): Learn prevention strategies, safety resources, and ways to respond when someone wanders or goes missing.

AMERICAN RED CROSS: Learn about emergency preparedness and disaster relief resources.

MEET OUR FIRST RESPONDERS!

Explore Emergency Vehicles

Participants will have an opportunity to see emergency vehicles up close and learn how they are used to help our community.

FIRE TRUCK (LFR): Explore the fire truck and learn about fire and emergency response.

AMBULANCE (UMC): Learn about emergency medical response and what happens when an ambulance arrives.

POLICE VEHICLES (TTUPD/LPD/LSO/DPS): Explore police vehicles and learn about the role of law enforcement during emergencies.
