Camp Burkhart

Camp Burkhart is offered to elementary students with ASD for one week during the summer. Focused ABA staff plan an exciting week of therapeutic projects and games for the students. With the help of volunteers our camps have been a huge success. Week-long high school and middle school camps are offered by the Transition Academy. Outpatient Services

- Outpatient services provide targeted supports to individuals with autism and their families through focused ABA services, social skills classes and contracted consultations.
- Focused ABA services will address specific behavior concerns and goals through individual treatment, parent training, social opportunities and treatment transition planning. Clients accepted into the program will be eligible for up to 30 hours of one-on-one and small group therapy each month, for up to 6 months each year. - The Children's Autism Program through Texas Health and Human Services provides financial support to focused ABA children aged 3-15 years with a formal diagnosis of ASD. The Burkhart Center also accepts insurance payment and private pay options.
- Social skills classes will be offered for individuals of all ages with ASD. Classes will run 2 times each semester and have a variety of themes. Dates and times will be posted on our website.
- Contracted consultations with outside agencies can also be provided to organizations seeking assistance with training or behavioral support.
