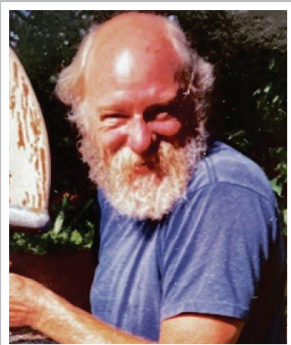




The Legacy Lives

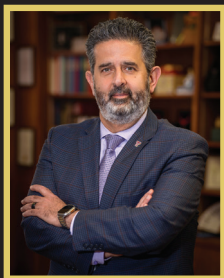
We rolled out the red carpet to celebrate our superstar students at our annual Awards Ceremony.
