To nominate a candidate as Young Distinguished Engineer of the Year, please complete the nomination form and submit it per the instructions below. Please attach a copy of the nominee's current vitae/resume to the nomination form along with a letter explaining why you feel this individual should receive the award. The nomination letter best conveys the significance of the nominee's professional and other civic and personal accomplishments. You are encouraged, but not required, to obtain other letters that help support the individual's candidacy. Items to be included in the nomination packet are:

- Nomination Form
- Current Vitae/Resume
- Letters of recommendation
- Supporting documentation, i.e. journal publications, news or research articles, etc. (suggested)

Upon receipt of the nomination packet you will receive a confirmation notice. Nominations shall be kept on file and considered for a period of three years from the date of the original nomination.

The Young Distinguished Engineer award will be announced at the college's Distinguished Engineer Luncheon.

As part of the Whitacre College of Engineering family, you are in an excellent position to witness and recognize our former students who excel in their fields. We value your perspective and appreciate your consideration of our request.

To be eligible for the Young Distinguished Engineer Award, an individual must:

- Be an alumnus of the Whitacre College of Engineering who received his/her undergraduate degree within the last 15 years.
- Be exceptional in his/her profession, life work, or other worthy endeavors.
- Be actively involved in Texas Tech and the college through associations, committees, etc.
- Be a person of such integrity, stature, and demonstrated ability that faculty, staff, students, and alumni will take pride in and be inspired by his/her recognition.
- Attend the college's Distinguished Engineer Luncheon to receive the award.
