



Study Abroad Checklist

- Apply for a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) at fsaid.ed.gov. If you are a dependent student, both you and your parent need an FSA ID to electronically sign your FAFSA.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the current year to apply for all federal, state, and institutional aid at fafsa.gov. Texas Tech school code 003644.
- Enroll in at least 6 credit hours to receive summer financial aid.
- View your Financial Aid Notification at raiderlink.ttu.edu. Click on the My Tech Tab, choose Student Financial Aid & Scholarships, and select View and Accept Aid Package. Then choose the Award Year, followed by the Accept Award Offer tab. You may accept none, some, or all of the financial aid you are offered.
- Check your Texas Tech email. We will contact you if there are additional requirements.
- Consider loan options if your financial aid does not cover your program costs. Go to financialaid.ttu.edu and click on Types of Aid.
- Set up direct deposit through Student Business Services to receive your financial aid refund. sbs.ttu.edu
- Search for external scholarships: scholarships.ttu.edu, studyabroad.ttu.edu, pesa.ttu.edu, and Google.
- Contact the Scholarship Office if you receive a merit scholarship. Some scholarships cannot be used for study abroad. [806.742.3144](tel:806.742.3144).
- Federal regulations limit federal financial aid to no more than two semesters of study abroad or exchange at participating foreign universities or programs. No more than 25% of your educational program can be provided by a foreign university. All credit from foreign institutions accepted as credit toward your degree is counted in this two semester limit.
