College Knowledge (6th-8th)

An engaging presentation for middle schoolers to explore college readiness, degree options, and student life at Texas Tech through fun trivia and activities. It also highlights the university's rich history and traditions, connecting students with the spirit of being a Red Raider. Paired with a campus visit experience customized to each group's unique interests

Red Raider Academy: Ages 7-10
