



POSITION: Part-time Faculty Appointment, Industrial Engineering

The Opportunity

Texas Tech University-Costa Rica invites applications for several part-time faculty positions in Industrial Engineering, starting in Fall 2021. We seek candidates qualified to teach industrial engineering courses and labs in one or more of the following areas: advanced manufacturing systems; ergonomics; product safety; and additive manufacturing/3-D printing. Working in coordination with the Department of Industrial, Manufacturing, and Systems Engineering in Lubbock, Texas, as well as the academic leadership in Costa Rica, the successful candidate will contribute to Texas Tech-Costa Rica's mission by assisting in the delivery of our new bachelor's program in industrial engineering.

Successful candidates will be appointed as part-time instructors on the Texas Tech University-Costa Rica campus in Avenida Escazú, with simultaneous adjunct appointments at Texas Tech University Department of Industrial, Manufacturing, and Systems Engineering.

Responsibilities

- Teach 1-3 courses per year and participate in student learning assessment in those classes.
- Work closely with the Department of Industrial, Manufacturing, and Systems Engineering at Texas Tech University in Lubbock to assure Costa Rica students' attainment of desired learning outcomes.
- Contribute to the campus community, e.g., through community engagement, service, and executive education.

Qualifications

- Master's required in industrial, mechanical, or related engineering field (PhD preferred).
- A strong teaching record.
- Native or near-native competency in the English language.
