

SECTION I. GENDER-BASED HARASSMENT, SEXUAL MISCONDUCT, DISCRIMINATION, AND TITLE IX

Texas Tech University (TTU) has established policies and grievance procedures providing for prompt and equitable resolution of student complaints of discrimination and harassment, including sexual harassment, sexual violence, and other forms of sexual misconduct. In the event a student believes their rights under Title IX or other laws have been violated, TTU Operating Policies 40.02 and 40.03 (<https://www.depts.ttu.edu/opmanual/OP40.02.pdf>), TTUSystem Regulation 07.10, S 07.06A, and 07.06B. (<http://www.depts.ttu.edu/opmanual/OP40.03.pdf>) set forth procedures for filing, investigating, and resolving complaints of harassment and discrimination.
