

Texas Tech ECE Industrial Advisory Board – Committee Structure

-- adopted October 14, 2011 --

Curriculum Committee-acts as liaison among the IAB and students and the ECE department in order to provide industry experience and consultation in the setting of curricula that meets ABET requirements and provides graduates with desirable knowledge and skills.

Development Committee-acts as liaison among IAB members, the ECE department, and the appropriate associated college/university staff to help define short and long-term goals, raise awareness to friends of the ECE department, and assist fundraising efforts.

Faculty/Staff Relations Committee-acts as liaison between IAB members and the ECE Faculty/Staff: promoting a mutual awareness of capabilities, experiences and current projects, and providing feedback to IAB members concerning departmental issues and needs.

Student Relations Committee- acts as liaison between IAB members and the ECE students: promoting a mutual awareness of capabilities, experiences and current projects, and providing feedback to IAB members concerning departmental issues. Coordinate the IAB student grants program. Facilitate student feedback to the ECE department and departmental responses to students.

Nominating Committee- gathers nominations from IAB members, ECE faculty or staff, or friends of the department for IAB membership, and works with the ECE department to gather nominations for the ECE Academy and COE Distinguished Engineer awards.

Diversity Committee – reinforce the importance and support the promotion of diversity within the ECE department and the Whitacre College of Engineering.
