

Curriculum and Instruction Ph.D. with a specialization in STEM Application- Supplemental Requirements

Resume – Include contact information; education; professional experience (especially related to STEM and STEM teaching); honors and awards; publications/presentations (if any); professional organization membership; consulting or advisory activities

Applicant Statement – In the applicant statement, you discuss your academic background, your work experience, future plans which this degree will help you pursue, and personal insights that led you to decide to pursue this degree in STEM education.

Three recommendation letters – Please provide three recommendation letters; at least one of your recommenders should speak to your success as a teacher in STEM.

Writing Sample – Please provide a writing sample. If possible, the sample should be academic in nature.

GRE Scores – Your GRE scores must be from within the last five years. Please request that ETS send an official score report to Texas Tech University (institution code 6827).
