

Instructional Technology Ed.D. Application- Supplemental Requirements

Curriculum Vitae (CV) – Applicants should submit a CV that includes contact details, educational background, professional experiences, and other relevant information like publications, awards, memberships, and community service.

Personal & Research Statement – The applicants include a document to discuss their reasons for pursuing a doctoral degree in Instructional Technology, career vision five years from now, past research experience, and the research areas they intend to study.

Three Recommendation Letters – Please provide three recommendation letters from professional or academic references.

Writing Sample – Please provide a writing sample. Acceptable examples include previous submissions for coursework, grant proposals, published materials, etc.

GRE Scores – Your GRE scores must be from within the last five years. Please request that ETS send an official score report to Texas Tech University (institution code 6827).
