Ph.D.:

1. Resume: Contact information; education; professional experience; honors and awards; publications/presentations; membership in professional organization/related to education; consulting or advisory activities in education

2. Statement of Purpose:

Demonstrate your professional experiences related to the general track in Curriculum & Instruction (2 or 3 pages, no more than 750 words)

- How have your background and experiences motivated you to pursue a doctoral degree in the general track of Curriculum and Instruction?
- What are your research interests and why do you want to pursue them?
- Why are you applying for the general track? Which C&I faculty member you would wish to work with?
- What are your educational or professional goals with this specific terminal degree?
- 3. Academic Writing Sample: Academic writing samples show the quality of your academic work and writing proficiency (e.g., published articles and book chapters, or papers written during your master or undergraduate studies).
- 4. Three Letters of Recommendation: One-to-two-page letters of recommendation from individuals in academic or academic adjacent fields who can discuss your professional performance and/or scholastic ability.
- 5. Unofficial Transcripts of Undergraduate and Master's Degrees
- 6. GRE scores
