

# Teacher Advancement Program (TAP) Rubric Performance Assessment Results for students participating in **Tech Teach Across Rural Texas (TTART)**

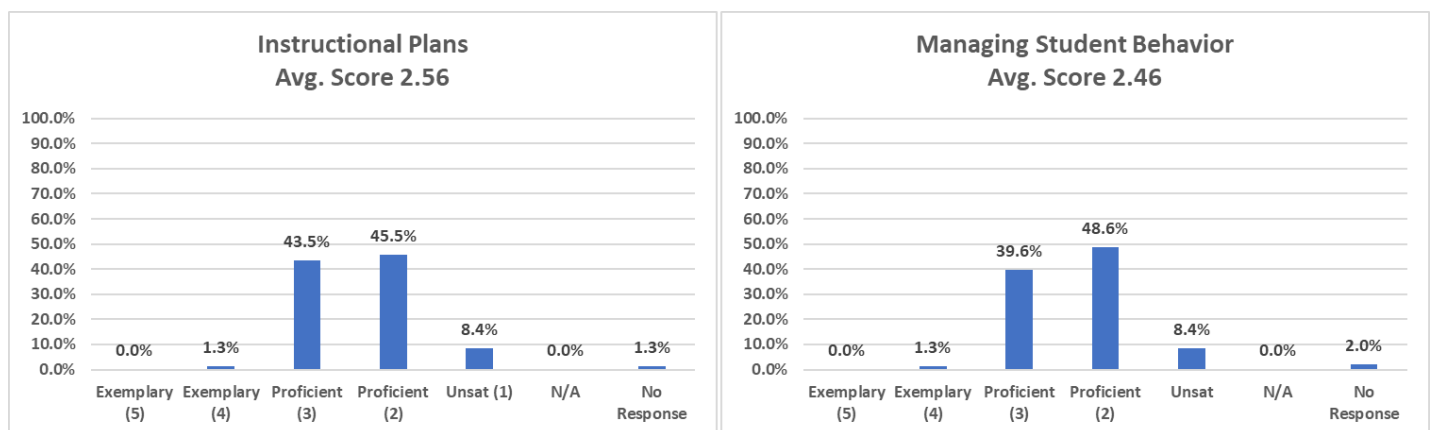
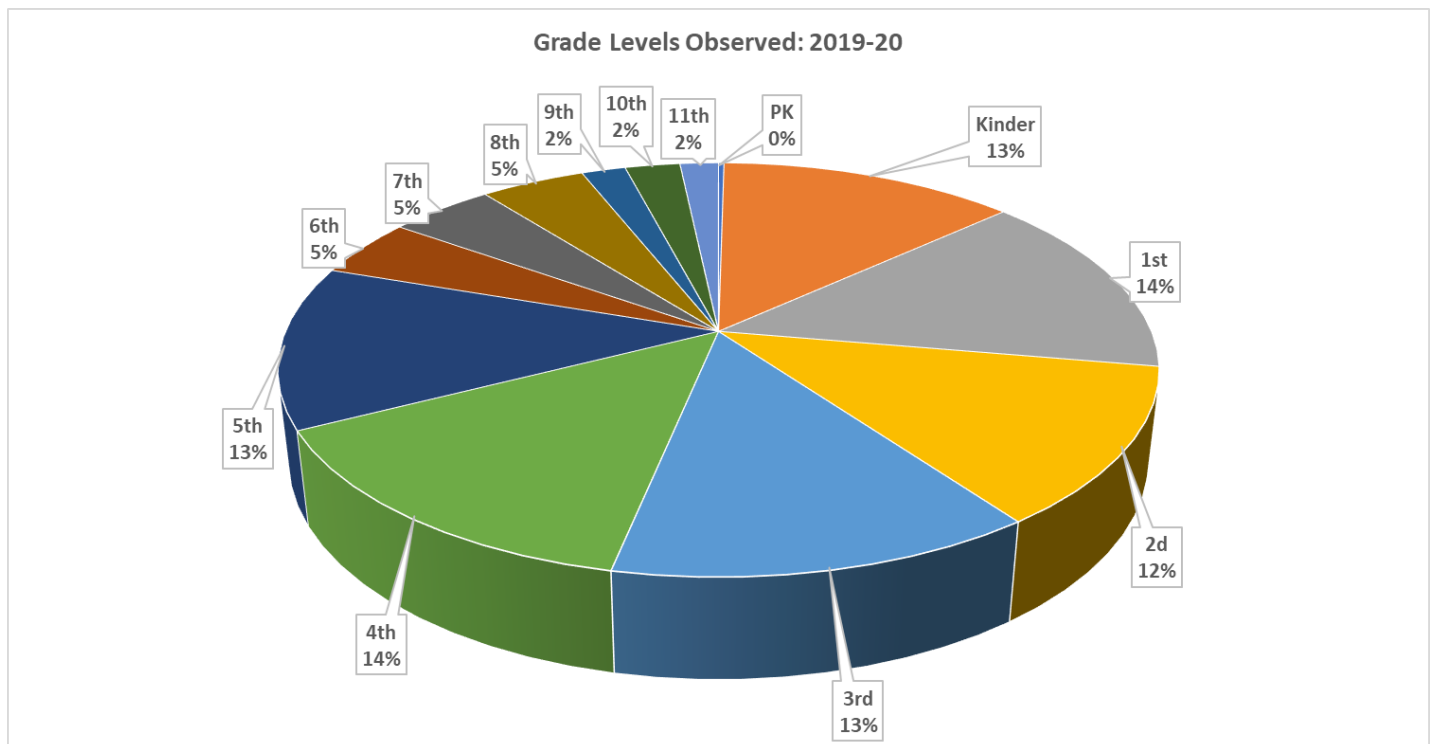

**Teachers are rated on the following scale:**

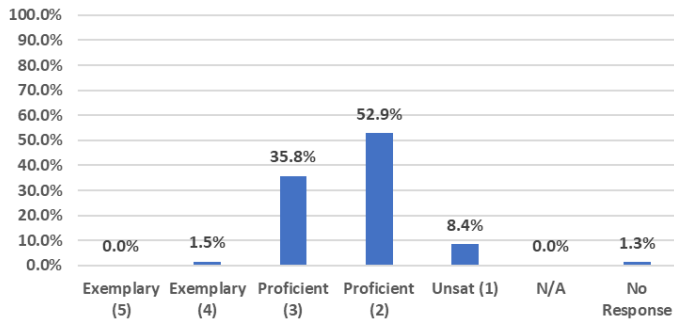
1 (Unsatisfactory), 2 (Proficient), 3 (Proficient), 4 (Exemplary), 5 (Exemplary)



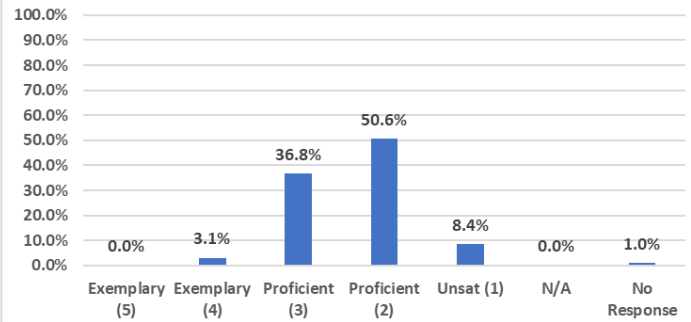

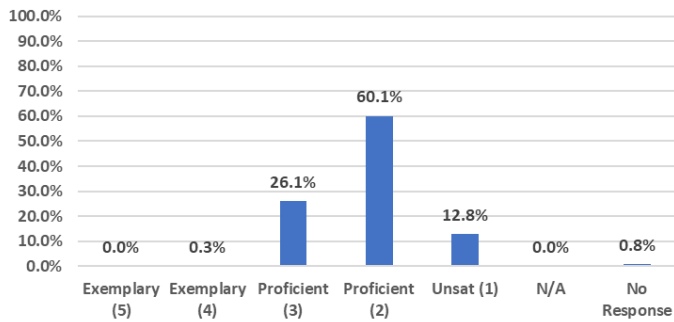

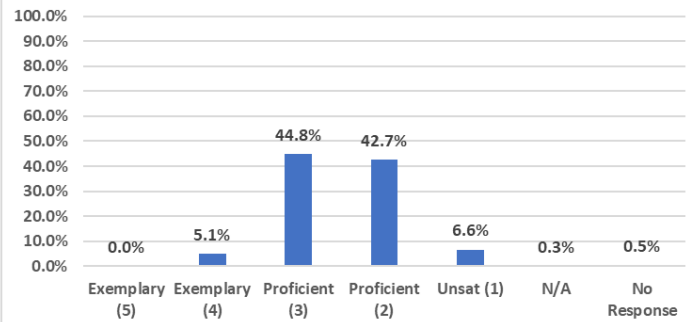
### Presenting Instructional Content Avg. Score 2.5



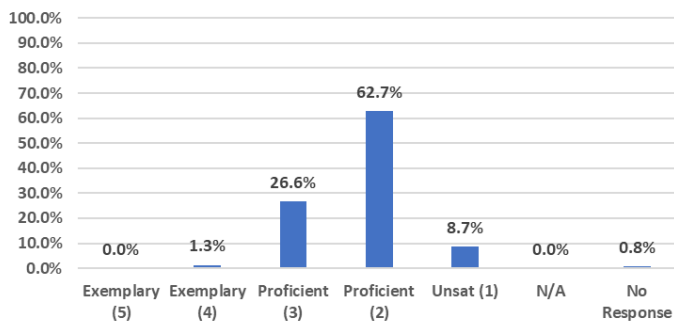
### Lesson structure & Pacing Avg. Score 2.3



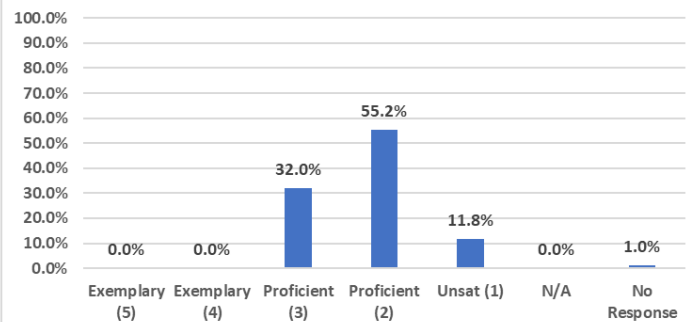

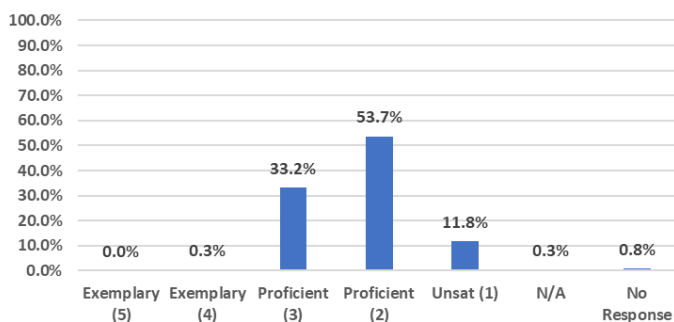

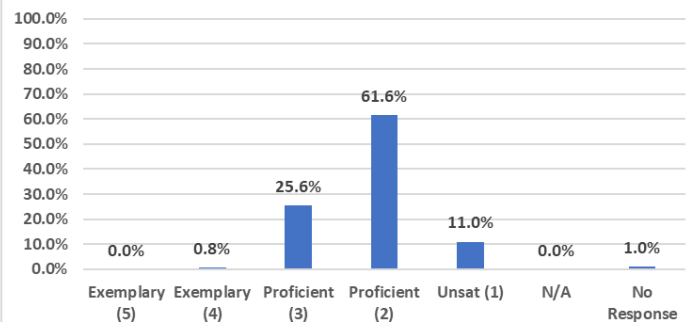

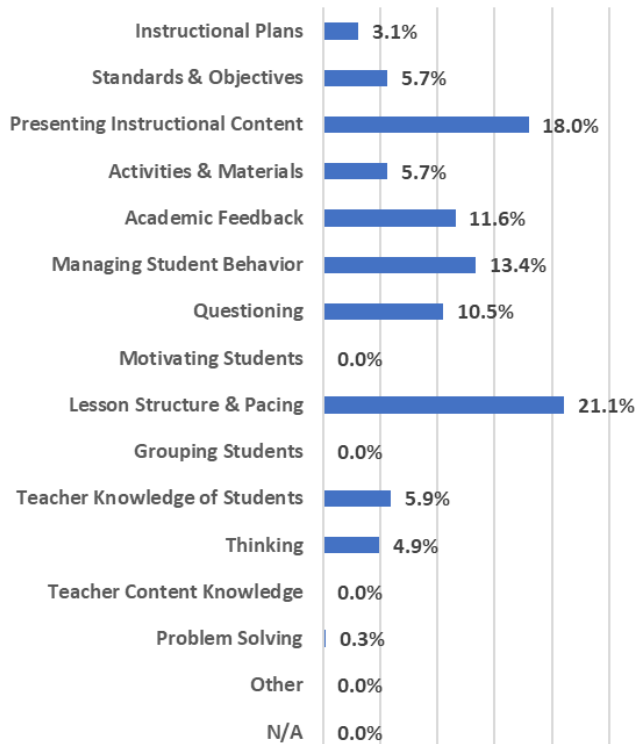

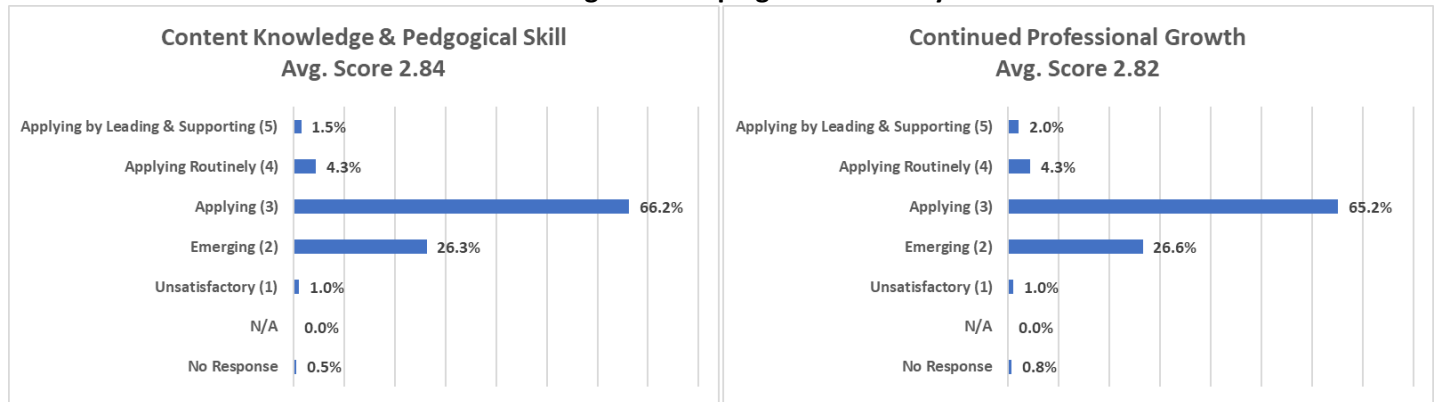
