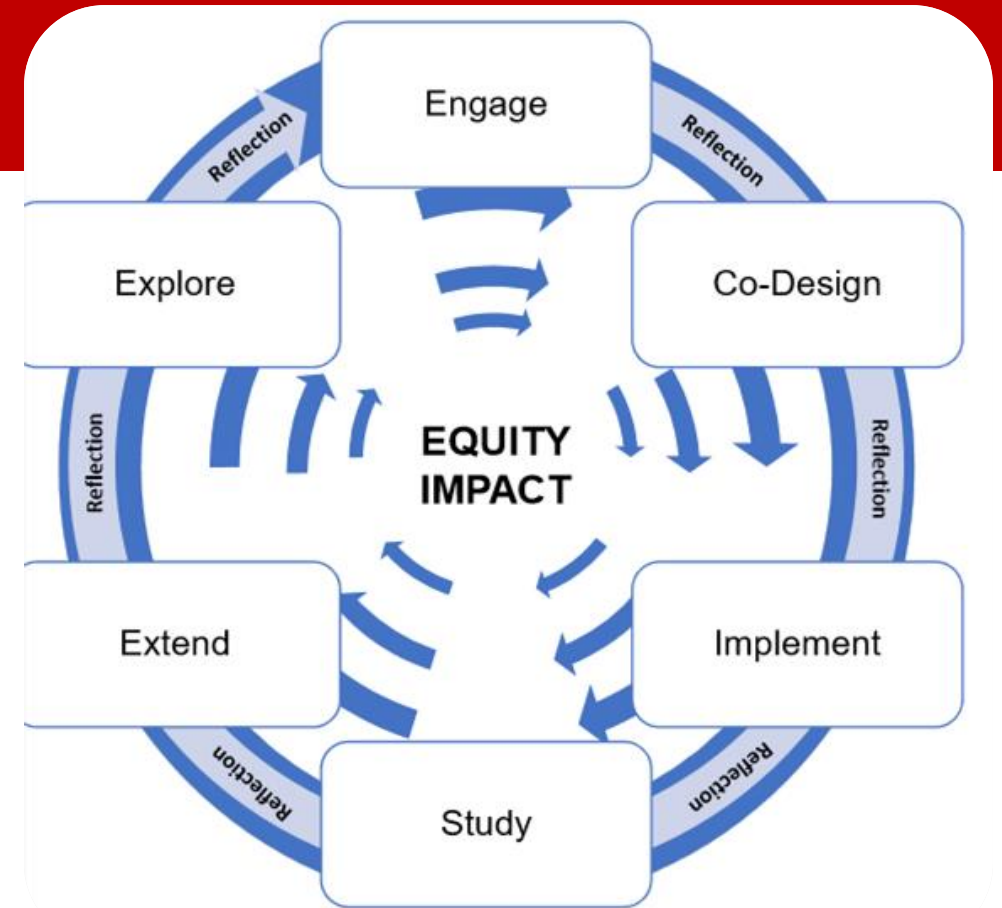


CONVERSATIONS ON EDUCATION LAW & SOCIAL JUSTICE POLICY PROJECT
