Certified Vision Rehabilitation Professional

Vision Bermuda (formerly The Bermuda Society for the Blind) delivers a range of programmes and services for people who are blind and visually impaired.

We require a qualified and experienced professional with dual certification in Vision Rehabilitation Therapy and Orientation & Mobility training (North America), or a certified Vision Rehabilitation Officer (UK), or an individual with equivalent training and certification in vision rehabilitation. An additional qualification in integrated health and social care is desirable.

Responsibilities include:

- Conduct assessments of vision impaired individuals to develop and provide individual plans in the home and community, educational and vocational settings.
- Provide programmes and services to offer vision rehabilitation therapy, orientation & mobility training and assistive technology instruction.
- Develop and conduct group rehabilitation training based upon identified needs.
- Collaborate with relevant community agencies, government departments and educational/healthcare professionals to assist in delivering integrated, person-centred care.
- Provide community education and outreach promoting visual health and the programmes and services offered by Vision Bermuda.
- Maintain records and provide reports required for the administration of programmes and services.
- Travel as required to conduct in-home and community based services.
- Supervise professionals and volunteers in the Vision Rehabilitation Therapy programme.

Qualifications

- Master's Degree in Vision Rehabilitation Therapy (VRT) or equivalent Higher Education with an active, current full and unrestricted certification in Vision Rehabilitation Therapy (CVRT) granted by the Academy of Certification of Vision Rehabilitation & Education Professionals (ACVREP) and in Orientation & Mobility Training (COMS) (North America); or a UK diploma or Master's degree in Rehabilitation Work (Visual Impairment); or equivalent certifications.
- Minimum five (5) years experience as a Vision Rehabilitation Professional or equivalent in a related field in rehabilitation.
- Strong skills with assistive technology and current clinical therapies and innovations are required.
- Competence with programme development, management and evaluation is essential.
- Experience in an integrated health and social care environment would be an asset.
- The ability to promote programmes and services to clients and donors is desirable.
- Valid Bermuda driver's license or ability to obtain one.
