Cypress Fairbanks Independent School District is located in northwest Houston. It is the third largest school district in Texas with 92 schools and over 115,000 enrolled students. The Northwest Harris County Cooperative for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (NWHCCDHH) is a Regional Day School Program for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing located in Cypress Fairbanks ISD. This Cooperative serves six member districts including Cy Fair ISD, Spring ISD, Klein ISD, Spring Branch ISD, Tomball ISD, and Waller ISD. The NWHCCDHH employs over 80 teachers, interpreters, interpreter interns, and support staff who support students from birth through 12<sup>th</sup> grade through parent-infant, itinerant, and site based services. In addition, we provide additional services with a in-house audiology staff and speech pathologist who are knowledgeable about working with our deaf and hard of hearing students.

It is the vision of the NWHCCDHH to be an exemplary educational community. We aim to provide a comprehensive education for our deaf and hard of hearing students. The NWHCCDHH uses a Total Communication approach using sign base and/or listening and spoken language strategies to educate deaf and hard of hearing students.
