

President's Transfer Scholarship	3.0 GPA & Texas Resident with 30 transferable hours, and financial need as evidenced by the FAFSA	\$4,500/year
IMPACT Competitive Transfer Scholarship	3.0 GPA & 30 transferable hours from a community college	\$2,500/year

TEACH GRANT

Federally funded grant program for students who intend to teach in schools that serve students from low-income families for at least four years and are seeking certification in a high-need teaching fields. TECHTEACH SCHOLARSHIP

The TechTeach scholarship is awarded to students based on their performance in the program. Students must perform well on their performance assessments, pass their certification exam, have a finical need based on submitting a FAFSA and have a competitive GPA. STEP 2

Students that complete the AAT program at South Plains College are eligible to participate in the STEP 2 support program. The program provides stipends to cover teacher certification expenses as well as resources to ensure a successful transition to the university. Stipend amounts range from \$250 - \$1,000. RED RAIDER GUARANTEE

The Red Raider Guarantee ensures tuition and mandatory fees up to 30 credit hours per year, will be paid by a combination of federal, state, and institutional funds. Eligible students must apply, be accepted for admission and have a complete financial aid (FAFSA), www.depts.ttu.edu/financialaid/redraiderguarantee (Contingent upon state funding.)
